From Friday 30th May to Sunday 8th June, each day of the guide focuses on a powerful theme — like Promise, Power, Family, Nations, and Shining. There's also a catchy theme song, "You Give Power," plus a daily worship song to sing along with.

You can use this guide as a family devotion time in the morning, at bedtime, or around the kitchen table. Each page is packed with colour, creativity, and opportunities to grow in prayer together.

And there's something really special about this guide — your children's prayers are part of a bigger global move of prayer! Every day, adults around the world are also praying — especially for revival among the Jewish people, that they would know Jesus as their Messiah. You'll find simple ways your children can join in with these global prayers, and lift their voices in unity with the wider Church.

We believe God will speak to your children as they pray – and you might just be inspired by their faith too.

So grab your Bibles, some colouring pens, and maybe even a bowl of popcorn... because this Pentecost, we're going on a Spirit-filled adventure together!

As Acts 1:8 reminds us:

"You will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses..."

WHY ARE WE PRAYING FOR THE JEWISH PEOPLE?



You might be wondering, "Why are we praying for the Jewish people every day during this Pentecost adventure?" That's a great question – and the answer is pretty amazing!

Let's go back in time to the Bible. Did you know that Jesus was Jewish? So were His disciples, Mary and Joseph, the prophets — even Paul who wrote many of the letters in the New Testament! The Jewish people were the first ones God chose to show the world what He is like. He made promises to them that He still remembers today.



A long time ago, God said through the prophets that He would bless the Jewish people, bring them back to their land (Israel), and send the Holy Spirit to change their hearts. And guess what? That started happening on the day of Pentecost! When the Holy Spirit was poured out in Jerusalem, it was mostly Jewish people who heard the message first and believed in Jesus. That's why Pentecost is such a special time — it's like a birthday party for the Church, and the Jewish people were there at the very start!

But many Jewish people around the world still don't know that Jesus is their Messiah — the one God promised to send to save them. That's why we pray! We ask God to open their hearts, to pour out His Spirit, and to bring peace to places like Jerusalem and Israel.

Your grown-ups might be praying for some big things too — for revival in Jewish communities, for unity between Jewish and Arab believers, and for the Gospel to go out across the Middle East. You're not too young to join in! When kids pray, heaven listens.

Think of it like being part of a big team: the adults are praying, pastors are praying, churches around the world are praying — and you get to join in too! Every time you pray, you're adding your voice to a chorus of love and hope for God's special people.

So as you go through this adventure, remember: your prayers matter. God hears you. And you're helping write a beautiful story — one where the Jewish people discover just how much Jesus loves them.

MORE ABOUT JUSTIN...

Justin was diagnosed with autism at two. He was unable to speak until five. He underwent 40 hours of therapy weekly. He was not accepted by 15 schools before finally finding one. At seven, his writing skill was assessed at just 0.1 percent, but his mother's efforts to teach him how to hold a pencil and write bore fruit. By eight, Justin's writing was published by a national publisher.

Despite his difficulties in speaking and the daily struggles with his autism, Justin uses his writing to inspire and encourage others worldwide, turning his challenges into a source of strength. His writing can be seen on Instagram

READ THE STORY!

Jesus promises the Holy Spirit - John 14:16-17; Acts 1:4-5

STORY INTRO...

Jesus told His friends, "I will ask the Father, and He will give you another Helper to be with you forever — the Spirit of truth". He also said, "Wait for the gift my Father promised". Jesus knew His disciples couldn't do God's work alone. He promised to send the Holy Spirit — a special gift — to help them!

LET'S THINK ABOUT IT:

Have you ever been promised a really special gift? Maybe at Christmas or your birthday? Jesus' friends had to wait expectantly for the gift of the Holy Spirit. But when the Spirit came, it changed everything! The Holy Spirit gives us God's power, God's love, and God's help – so we can follow Jesus every day.

LET'S PRAY TOGETHER:

Dear God, thank You for sending the Holy Spirit! Thank You that I don't have to follow Jesus on my own. Please help me understand the Holy Spirit better, and help me get ready for all You want to give me. Fill me with Your love today. In Jesus' name, Amen.

ACTION IDEA:

Draw a picture of a gift box. Inside, write or draw the words: LOVE, POWER, HELP - the gifts the Holy Spirit brings you!



MEMORY VERSE:

"You will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you." - Acts 1:8a



JUSTIN'S THOUGHT

Imagine being one of Jesus' friends and hearing Him say, "I'm going to send you a Helper who will be with you forever!" That's the Holy Spirit. And guess what? That promise is for us too! The Holy Spirit is like a best friend who never leaves us and always helps us follow Jesus.

TODAY'S THEME:

WRITING

READ THE STORY!

The disciples wait in the upper room - Acts 1:12-14



After Jesus went back to heaven, His friends went to an upstairs room in Jerusalem. The Bible says, "They all joined together constantly in prayer". They didn't know exactly when the Holy Spirit would come — but they trusted God and waited together.

LET'S THINK ABOUT IT:

Sometimes waiting can feel hard! But waiting can also be a time to pray and trust God. Jesus' friends prayed together in the upper room — they didn't rush off or get busy with other things. Can you think of a time when you waited and trusted God?

LET'S PRAY TOGETHER:

Dear God, help me be patient when I'm waiting for You to answer. Help me remember that You are always working, even when I can't see it. Teach me to pray with my friends and family, just like the disciples did. In Jesus' name, Amen.

Find a quiet spot today (maybe your room or garden) and sit still for one minute. Tell God you are waiting and listening.




MEMORY VERSE:

READ THE STORY!

The coming of the Holy Spirit - Acts 2:1-4
