

WHY ARE WE PRAYING FOR THE HINDU PEOPLE?

You might be wondering, "Why are we praying for the Hindu people every day during this adventure?" That's a great question – and the answer is amazing!

There are over one billion Hindu people in the world today. Most live in India and Nepal, but there are Hindu families in many other countries too – places like the UK, USA, Kenya, and even right near where you live. Behind all the colorful festivals, busy temples, and daily prayers are real people – moms and dads, children and grandparents – and God loves every single one of them.

The Bible says God created all people in His image (Genesis 1:27). That means every Hindu child is wonderfully made and special to Him. But many Hindu people don't yet know Jesus, the true Light of the World. During the Hindu festival of Diwali, houses and streets are filled with lamps and fireworks to celebrate "light winning over darkness." But only Jesus can bring the real light that never goes out.

That's why we pray! We ask God to show Hindu families that He sees them, loves them, and sent His Son Jesus to save them.



Your grown-ups might be praying for some big things too - for the Gospel to spread in India, for children to hear about Jesus, and for whole families to follow Him together. You're not too young to join in! When kids pray, heaven listens.

Think of it like being part of a big team: the adults are praying, pastors are praying, churches around the world are praying - and you get to join them! God loves to hear children pray! Every time you pray, you are shining God's light into the Hindu world.

So as you go through this adventure, remember: your prayers matter. God hears you. And you're helping write a beautiful story - one where Hindu children and families discover just how much Jesus loves them.



Justin is an incredibly talented young Indonesian writer. He overcame the massive challenges of autism, difficulty speaking and daily struggles to publish his first book at the age of 8. Despite his difficulties, Justin uses his writing to inspire and encourage others worldwide, turning his challenges into a source of strength.

MORE ABOUT JUSTIN...

Justin was diagnosed with autism at two. He was unable to speak until five. He underwent 40 hours of therapy weekly. He was not accepted by 15 schools before finally finding one. At seven, his writing skill was assessed at just 0.1 percent, but his mother's efforts to teach him how to hold a pencil and write bore fruit. By eight, Justin's writing was published by a national publisher.

Despite his difficulties in speaking and the daily struggles with his autism, Justin uses his writing to inspire and encourage others worldwide, turning his challenges into a source of strength. His writing can be seen on Instagram @justinyoungwriter, where he continues to share his journey and connect with people around the world.




One of the most exciting things we can remember as we pray is that **Jesus** is the **Light of the World!** His light shines in every place, even where there is darkness.

Welcome, explorer! Today begins your amazing adventure with God. Get ready to discover how much Jesus loves the people of India and how your prayers matter!



READ THE STORY!

Luke 15:3-7



STORY INTRO...

<mark>Jesus told a story about a s</mark>hepherd with 100 sheep. One wandered away and got lost. The shepherd left the 99 safe ones to search for the one. When he found it, he was so happy he carried it home on his shoulders!



LETS THINK ABOUT IT:

Have you ever felt left out, forgotten, or not chosen? Jesus says you are never forgotten! Just like the shepherd looked for the one lost sheep, God searches for each of us. That shows how precious we are to Him. Heaven celebrates when even one person is found!



LET'S PRAY TOGETHER

Dear God, thank You that You never forget me. Please help every child, especially those who feel lonely or left out, to know how precious they are to You. Amen.



ACTION IDEA:

Draw a big heart with one sheep inside. Write: "God loves me!" Then pray for a child who might feel left out.



MEMORY VERSE:

"The Son of Man came to seek and save the lost." - Luke 19:10



JUSTIN'S THOUGHT

Sometimes I feel invisible, like I don't belong. But God always finds me. He is the Shepherd who looks for the one. If you notice someone sitting alone, maybe you are the friend God is sending.





GROWN UPS

Today, adults are praying for the oppressed and forgotten in India -Dalits, women, migrants, and the poor - that God's love brings dignity and hope.

- > Jesus, lift up every forgotten child in India with Your love.
- > Lord, defend the poor, Dalits, and the oppressed with justice.







Saturday 18th October

TODAYS THEME

Jesus sees every person in the crowd

Hi friend! Today you'll meet new children who live far away. Together we'll discover their world and pray for them to know Jesus' light!



READ THE STORY!

John 6:1-14



STORY INTRO...

A huge crowd followed Jesus. They were hungry, but only one boy had a lunch — five loaves and two fish. Jesus blessed the food, and everyone ate until they were full!



LETS THINK ABOUT IT:

Imagine standing in a big crowd of thousands — it's easy to feel small. But Jesus saw the boy with his little lunch and used it to feed everyone. God doesn't just see crowds; He sees each person. That means He sees you, knows your name, and cares about your life.



LET'S PRAY TOGETHER

Thank You, Jesus, that You see me even in a big crowd. Help me remember that I matter to You. Amen.



ACTION IDEA:

Count five things you have today (toys, clothes, food) and thank God for them.



MEMORY VERSE:

"Jesus saw the great crowd and had compassion on them." - Mark 6:34



JUSTIN'S THOUGHT

In a crowd it's easy to feel small. But Jesus never loses sight of a single face. He even saw one boy's lunch and used it to feed many. Your little act can be part of His big miracle.





GROWN UPS

Today, adults are thinking about India's huge crowds, where millions feel unseen. They are praying that each one will hear the Gospel and meet Jesus personally.

LETS PRAY

> God, see every person in India's huge crowds and bring hope.

> Jesus, let Your Gospel shine brightly in cities full of people.







Sunday 19th October

TODAYS THEME IMPROPED

God cares for workers far from home

Welcome back, adventurer! Today we'll peek into colorful homes and bustling streets. Let's pray that every child there feels God's joy and hope inside!



READ THE STORY!

Luke 10:25-37



STORY INTRO...

Jesus told about a man on a journey who was attacked. People passed by without helping, but a Samaritan stopped. He cared for the man, bandaged his wounds, and took him to safety.



LETS THINK ABOUT IT:

Life can feel like a journey — sometimes exciting, sometimes hard. Migrant workers travel far from home to earn money, often feeling lonely. In Jesus' story, the Good Samaritan noticed someone in need and helped. God cares about people far from home and wants us to notice and care too.



LET'S PRAY TOGETHER

Dear God, help me be kind to people who feel far from home. Make me brave enough to care for others. Amen.



ACTION IDEA:

Make a "kindness card" for someone who isn't in your family — maybe a neighbor or teacher.



MEMORY VERSE:

"Love your neighbor as yourself."

- Luke 10:27



JUSTIN'S THOUGHT

I once felt lost on a school trip. Scared, until someone came to help. Many kids feel far from home. We can be like the Samaritan by showing kindness. A smile or small help can bring hope.





GROWN UPS

Today, adults are praying for migrant workers who travel far from home. They ask God to protect families left behind and bring dignity and fairness.

- > Lord, comfort children whose parents travel far to find work.
- > Jesus, protect families of migrant workers and fill them with hope.







Monday 20th October

TODAYS THEME PEACE

Jesus calms storms of fear and shame





Hello, shining star! Today you'll see how children just like you go to school, play, and dream. Let's ask Jesus to guide their steps!



READ THE STORY!

Mark 4:35-41



STORY INTRO...

One night, Jesus' friends were in a boat when a big storm came. The waves crashed, and they were scared! Jesus stood up and said, "Quiet! Be still!" and the storm stopped.



LETS THINK ABOUT IT:

Storms are scary, and sometimes life feels like a storm inside us too – fear, worry, or shame can make our hearts shake. But Jesus is stronger than any storm! He can calm our fears, give us peace, and remind us we are safe in His love.



LET'S PRAY TOGETHER

Lord Jesus, when I feel afraid, please give me peace. Thank You that You are stronger than any storm. Amen.



ACTION IDEA:

Draw big waves. Then write "Jesus gives me peace" across the top.



MEMORY VERSE:

"Do not be afraid, for I am with you." — Isaiah 41:10



JUSTIN'S THOUGHT

I get worried before tests or at night. When I whisper to Jesus, He calms the storm in me. Say, "Jesus, I trust You." Let His peace be stronger than fear.



GROWN UPS

Today, adults are praying for Hindus weighed down by fear, shame, and anxiety. They ask Jesus to give peace, courage, and freedom in His love.

- > Jesus, calm fears in Hindu children and give them Your peace.
- > Lord, heal hidden shame and remind children they are deeply loved.







Tuesday 21st October

TODAYS THEME TREASURE

Every child is precious in God's eyes



Hi explorer! Today's journey takes us into families and friendships. As we pray, imagine God's big family growing with love and laughter everywhere!



READ THE STORY!

Matthew 13:44



STORY INTRO...

Jesus said God's Kingdom is like treasure hidden in a field. A man found it and sold everything so he could buy the field and have the treasure.



LETS THINK ABOUT IT:

Think about something very valuable — maybe gold, jewels, or a rare coin. That's how God feels about us! We are His treasure, and He gave His Son, Jesus, to rescue us. Every child — in every country — is precious to Him. He doesn't want to lose even one.



LET'S PRAY TOGETHER

Dear Father, thank You for making me Your treasure. Help me treasure You more than anything else. Amen.



ACTION IDEA:

Hide a coin or toy. Let someone find it, then tell them, "That's how God finds us!"



MEMORY VERSE:

"You are precious and honored in my sight." – Isaiah 43:4



JUSTIN'S THOUGHT

I once lost my favourite handphone and felt joy when I found it. God feels that way about us. We are His treasure. Treat people like treasure too – because they are precious to Him.





GROWN UPS

Today, adults are praying for vulnerable groups in India – children, widows, and the elderly – asking God to protect, rescue, and reveal His treasure of salvation.

LETS PRAY

> God, show widows, orphans, and elderly that they are precious.

> Jesus, protect vulnerable children in India and reveal Your great treasure.







Wednesday 22nd October

TODAYS THEME HEALING

Jesus brings peace where people are divided

Welcome, prayer warrior! Today you'll hear about challenges children face. Don't worry—God is stronger! Your prayers can bring courage, comfort, and peace to them.



READ THE STORY!

Matthew 21:28-32



STORY INTRO...

A father asked his two sons to work in his vineyard. One said "no" but later went; the other said "yes" but didn't go. Jesus showed that obeying God brings true peace.



LETS THINK ABOUT IT:

Sometimes families argue, friends fight, or nations are divided. That hurts people and breaks God's heart. But Jesus loves to bring healing where there is pain and peace where there is fighting. He invites us to be peacemakers, showing His love with our words and actions.



LET'S PRAY TOGETHER

Lord Jesus, help me to do what You say, not just say the right words. Bring healing to families and peace to nations. Amen.



ACTION IDEA:

Make a paper chain. Write names of family or friends on each link, then pray for peace between them.



MEMORY VERSE:

"Blessed are the peacemakers, for they will be called children of God." — Matthew 5:9



JUSTIN'S THOUGHT

Sometimes when people don't understand me, my heart feels heavy. But when someone listens with kindness, it brings healing inside. Jesus heals broken places in us. You can be part of His healing by listening, smiling, and showing love.





GROWN UPS

Today, adults are praying for peace in divided communities. They ask God to heal India's land from violence, injustice, and hatred with His mercy and truth.

- > Lord, bring peace to divided families and heal angry communities.
- > Jesus, send peacemakers across India to shine with Your truth.







Thursday 23rd October

TODAYS THEME MELCOME

God's Kingdom welcomes the last and least

Hi there! Today we'll visit colorful festivals and celebrations. Imagine joy filling hearts—not just from parties, but from Jesus, the true Light of the World!



READ THE STORY!

Luke 14:15-24



STORY INTRO...

A man prepared a great banquet. When the invited guests refused, he welcomed the poor, disabled, and strangers from the streets. God's Kingdom is like that — everyone is invited!



LETS THINK ABOUT IT:

God doesn't invite only the rich, clever, or powerful. He welcomes everyone – even those who feel unimportant. Jesus makes space at His table for every person. In His Kingdom, there are no "outsiders." You and I are welcome, and so are children all over the world.



M LET'S PRAY TOGETHER

Thank You, Father, that Your Kingdom is open to everyone. Help me to welcome and love people, just like You do. Amen.



ACTION IDEA:

Set an extra place at dinner as a reminder to pray for children who don't yet know Jesus.



MEMORY VERSE:

"Therefore welcome one another as Christ has welcomed you." – Romans 15:7



JUSTIN'S THOUGHT

Being left out hurts. But when someone says, "Come join us," it feels like life. God's Kingdom is like that. Jesus invites everyone. This week, invite someone who feels outside.





GROWN UPS

Today, adults are praying for Dalits and others hurt by caste. They ask Jesus to bring healing, dignity, and equality through His Kingdom welcome and love.

- > Lord, welcome Dalit children into Your Kingdom family with joy.
- > Jesus, break barriers of caste and show everyone equal love.







Friday 24th October

TODAYS THEME COURAGE

God gives strength to stand for Jesus



Welcome back, mighty helper! Today we'll learn how God's Word is spreading. Let's pray that every child hears the good news of Jesus' love.



READ THE STORY!

Matthew 7:24-27



STORY INTRO...

A wise man built his house on a rock. When the storm came, the house stood strong. A foolish man built on sand, and his house fell with a crash.



LETS THINK ABOUT IT:

Life sometimes feels shaky — when we are laughed at or treated badly for following Jesus. But if we build our lives on His Word, we will be strong like the house on the rock. God gives us courage to stand firm, even when life is tough.



LET'S PRAY TOGETHER

Dear Jesus, help me build my life on You. Give me courage to follow You, even when it's difficult. Amen.



ACTION IDEA:

Build a tower with blocks or cups. As it stands tall, pray for kids to stand strong in faith.



MEMORY VERSE:

"Be strong and courageous... for the Lord your God is with you" - Joshua 1:9



JUSTIN'S THOUGHT

I get nervous speaking in front of people. Maybe you do too. But courage is not the absence of fear, it's trusting God while afraid. Ask Jesus for strength, and take one brave step.



GROWN UPS

Today, adults are praying for persecuted believers in India. They ask God to strengthen their faith, heal their wounds, and give courage to stand for Jesus.

LETS PRAY

> Lord, strengthen children who believe in You when they face trouble.

> Jesus, fill persecuted believers with courage to stand strong in faith.







Saturday 25th October

TODAYS THEME VALUE

Girls and boys are loved and seen



Hello friend! Today we'll see how prayers change lives. God listens to children just like you—your words can bring light into someone's darkness!



READ THE STORY!

Matthew 13:45-46



STORY INTRO...

Jesus said the Kingdom of Heaven is like a merchant looking for fine pearls. When he found one very precious pearl, he sold everything he had to buy it.



LETS THINK ABOUT IT:

Every pearl is special and beautiful — just like every child. God doesn't value one person more than another. Boys and girls, rich and poor, young and old — all are priceless to Him. His love makes each of us valuable beyond measure.



LET'S PRAY TOGETHER

Thank You, Lord, that I am precious to You. Help me see others as valuable too. Amen.



ACTION IDEA:

Find something shiny (like a bead or marble). Hold it in your hand and say, "God, thank You for loving me."



MEMORY VERSE:

"You are worth more than many sparrows."

- Matthew 10:31



JUSTIN'S THOUGHT

At school, some kids get teased for how they look or what they wear. That's not fair. Jesus says every child is valuable — like a priceless pearl. Next time you see someone teased, speak kindly or sit with them. Show them they are precious to God.





GROWN UPS

Today, adults are praying for women and girls across India. They ask God to protect them from harm, heal trauma, and restore their value in Christ.

LETS PRAY

> God, protect girls and boys from harm and unfair treatment.

> Jesus, show every child their true value and worth.

TODAYS THEME FOTURE

Jesus gives hope and joy to young hearts

Matthew 13:1-23



STORY INTRO...
